

For the last several decades, a glance into the interior of any American economy or even mid-sized car presented a display of cheap, hard, plastics and mouse fur upholstery that took good design, and made it look like a K-mart Christmas display. I always figure if I see a problem, there's someone in a company who sees it, and someone in the company who executes the evil plan. Who was it?

And so I found myself in Sarasota, Florida a few weeks ago, gazing at one of the two 1999 Ford Thunderbird prototypes, and wondered what happened to a car between the concept and reality. What happened to the hard tonneau? The nice leather? The aluminum grille?
