
Battery.

Q: WHERE CAN I GET BATTERIES FOR MY 56-57 BIRD?

A: You will be able to get batteries from any of the Bird's vendors, or you may buy them locally at various auto parts stores.

Those batteries are the large size batteries-you may ask for 29NF battery model in any brand.

This is the #1 sell by the Bird's vendors, looks like as the original one with individual vents. (Cost \$270.00)



The following are the ones that will fit in your birds: (Cost \$140.00-160.00)



A: Yes, CASCO can integrate the a/c vents into the dash. You will have to send them your dash, and they will do the job for you.

Q: IS THERE ANY SELLER THAT CAN INSTALL A MODERN STEERING IN THE BIRD?

A: Yes CASCO can do it for you- Rack & pinion, power steering, cruise control and tilt steering. For their information see previous question

Q: ARE THERE ANY SELLERS THAT CAN INSTALL FUEL INJECTION IN THE BIRD'S ENGINE?

A: Yes, CASCO will do it- see their information on this page.

Carburetor.

Q: MY CARBURETOR IS FLOODING, HOW DO I FIX IT?

A: It could because of two causes:

1. - If you have an electric fuel pump; probably it is sending too much gas pressure to the carburetor.

Use the electric pump just to prime the carburetor. Once it is primed, shot it off. If you use the electric pump all the time, install a pressure control equipment to control the pressure to 2 pounds (they cost approximately \$25.00 in any auto parts store).

2.- If the carburetor floods it off with the engine fuel pump, take the filter off, take the main screw that hold the filter off.

The following photos were taken in a double carburetor Bird, (E Bird) carburetors are almost identical except for linkage connections.



This photo is a regular carburetor in a one carburetor car.



Take off the 4 screw that hold the carburetor top (only 55 & 56).



When you take the top off, be carefull not to break the gasket- use a small screwdriver to separate the gasket from the carburetor.



Take off the ignition coil wire from the coil [it is the wire that goes from the coil to the center of the distributor.

(Shown below in dark green color).



Crank the engine and check the lever of the gas inside the carburetor, it should be about ½ inches from the border (level adjustment will be explain at the end)

If the gas continues flowing into the carburetor, you have to change the needle that opens and closes the flowing of gas.

Take off the screw shown on the photo (it holds the float in the carburetor). After you take it off the float will be loose- hold only by a little clip from the needle.



Photo shows the small clip attached to the needle (look in the same photo at the top, the needle without the clip and outside of the needle holder)



After you take the float off you will see a very soft float spring that pushes the float up. Leave it there and don't take it off.



On the previous photo you will see the needle holder almost touching the soft spring.

In the outside part of the carburetor you will see a cap that closes the hole of the needle holder-take it off.

Photo shows the needle holder (inside of carburetor)



After you take the cap off, you will see the needle holder head; take it off with a big screwdriver.



Replace a new needle holder; replace the cap cover well tied.

Install a new needle with the old clip; install the float reversing previous instructions. (Be sure the float spring top is in place inserted in the float small hole, and that the needle clip is inserted in the float.)

Crank the engine to check how is the gas level in the carburetor (you could do that with the electric pump)

If the level is O.K. place the top of the carburetor in place, be sure the two vertical tubing are inserted in place on the carburetor top, otherwise the four screws could not be tied.
