There will be two car classes: Classics [over 30 yrs. old] and modern cars.





Felipe Cos introduced The Second Edition of the "Thunderpedia of the Classic Thunderbird" at the Branson/Springfield Convention.


It has over 300 questions and asnwers, 1,000 photos, and over 150 pages, all related in how to fix our Classic Thunderbirds.

Hopefully the weather will start getting better and the "Birds" will come out. I for one, am looking forward to the Winter!





Fantom Works

Vacation, for some, is a time of relaxation, sipping cold drinks and lazing at the beach, but not for Frank and me. We were in Norfolk for a family reunion so during our down time we sought adventure and cars, the Fantom Works car restoration shop was the perfect spot for both. We arrived on a Saturday to find out that tours are on Friday. No worries though, Rob, the Operations Manager was exiting the building as we arrived and offered to give us a private tour of his "baby", the shop. Now this shop is the size of two football fields, the largest restoration shop of its kind. Talk about square footage and all the different cars; this is definitely Gear Head heaven. Fantom Works does it all when it comes to automobiles. They not only work on the standard body disciplines, but they also take care of the upholstery and all mechanical tasks. They have a complete machine shop and fabrication ability as well.

At Fantom Car Restoration, they are not interested in doing work for people who want to flip their cars, but rather for those of us who truly love our cars and want to bring them back to their former glory to enjoy them and pass on to future generations. Rob, our guide, has twenty five years of experience fixing antique cars as well as a specialty of fixing neon signs, juke boxes, porcelain signs, and electronics. If you can break it, Rob can fix it. Currently Rob is working on a recreation of a 1953 Tomassi-Ferrari, Hydroplane originally the Arno XI. This 3 point hydroplane still holds the world speed record with its V-12 / 4.5 liter Ferrari engine. This record was set on October 15, 1953; speed 241.7km/h (150.1 mph).

Frank and I originally become interested in Fantom Works car restoration when we saw a program on the Discovery Chanel's Velocity show titled "Wounded Wheels". Dan Short, the owner, and his crew took



a 1970 Chevelle SS clone and made it wheel chair accessible and with all controls operated by hand! Can you imagine the joy a veteran felt, to be able to drive a muscle car instead of the old "Mom van" that most disabled veterans, wheelchair bound, have to employ to accommodate their special needs.

During our stroll through this massive shop we were accompanied by the shop German Shepard, Heidi, who busied herself between us and exploring the many nooks and carnies of the area. She is friendly but I would not want to encounter her in the shop after hours or unescorted!

Our last step was the fully restored 1940's soda shop. This respite of days gone by is just as you would have found in your favorite Drug Store. Mom would plant her small charges at the counter to enjoy an ice cream soda so she could shop un-hassled.
