KEEPING THE REGISTRY

Past articles from the late Ford Johnson written in the late 1970's and early 1980's on the data he collected for the 1955 Thunderbirds were referred to as surveys. I realized that the registry I keep is actually a survey (collecting information) as well as a registry (keeping the information I have accumulated).

Your response to the registry (survey) has been great, and it continues to grow with a total of 17,900 serial numbers for the three years of Thunderbirds at this time.

To keep the registry user friendly for myself, I keep the information in an Excel format with the data for each Thunderbird on one line. This limits the data, but it is the format I started fifteen years ago; and I have continued the same. Including the codes from the data plate, there are also columns for the date the information was collected, the state in which the car resides, and the source from which I obtained the information. Each line carries a column for additional specific information on the car, such as Parts Car, Needs Restored etc.

Most of the Thunderbirds I come across in the registry range from fair to excellent condition. Below are eight categories that I have for the cars that are different in one way or another. In parenthesis are the number I have for each year and the total for the three years.

Needs Restored – This category is for cars that are restorable including project cars, barn finds, or others that need work to make them presentable and road worthy. The access to Thunderbird parts and expert advice help attract buyers to cars in this category.

(1955 - 95, 1956 - 77, 1957 - 89, Total = 261)

Parted Out – These cars have been parted out in the past with nothing left. Sometimes the owner saved the data plate.

(1955 - 71, 1956 - 20, 1957 - 25, Total = 116)

Restore or Parts – These cars are ones where I personally do not know if it is restorable. Most are very rough and, in my opinion are questionable. I have seen people buy these hoping to restore them and later find them for sale again in the same condition.

(1955 - 25, 1956 - 18, 1957 - 19, Total = 62)

Modified – These `Birds have a modified engine, usually a larger big block and sometimes include different running gear such as suspension, wheels, etc.

(1955 -20, 1956- 16, 1957 – 18, Total 54)

Customized – This category includes mild to wild customs that have been changed from the original factory configurations. Many have different paint schemes by adding flames or pinstripes. It may have a different grill, wheels, or modifications to body and/or interior. Usually the owner is making a personal "styling" statement making the car look unlike any other `Bird.

(1955 - 14, 1956 - 4, 1957 – 8, Total 26)

Frame Only – This is self-explanatory – The car simply does not have a body

or running gear.

(1955- 14, 1956 - 10, 1957 - 12, Total = 36)

Salvage – These cars are usually sold with a salvage title. Many are from fires in which the car was burnt severely and have no usable parts. Others have had flood damage and may be restorable.

(1955 - 6, 1956 - 7, 1957 - 12, Total = 25)

Parts Car – (Not included in the "parted out" category). These cars were being parted out when I received the information for the registry. They may or may not be running, and the only value is as a parts donor for other restoration projects.

(1955 - 10, 1956 - 2, 1957 - 8, Total = 20)

Some other information listed is

Note # - This indicates I have a personal letter from the owner that I filed in a separate hard bound note book. The letters are numbered for easy access such as note #78, etc. I have dozens of these letters on file.

Invoice – This indicates I have a copy of the original factory invoice for this car.

(1955 – 11, 1956 – 104, 1957 – 206, Total = 321)

Looking for History – Past or present owners are looking for information on this car.

(1955 – 34, 1956 – 27, 1957 – 60, Total = 121)

Stolen - These cars were at one time reported stolen and not recovered.

(1955 - 12, 1956 - 9, 1957 - 22, Total = 43)

Original owner - One owner Thunderbirds does not include one family owned.

(1955 - 10, 1956 - 3, 1957 - 8, Total = 21)

Data Plate missing

(1955 – 4, 1956 – 1, 1957 -5, Total 10)

This is a partial list of categories. Information is also kept on previous ownership, if the car is in a museum, overseas (636), plus many other items that could be of importance to a particular car.

I hope this helps explain how I keep the source of information. It is very helpful when someone is looking for information on a particular Thunderbird. The data gathered will be used in general terms in future articles and to help answer inquires I receive from Thunderbird owners. Undoubtedly the most important entry that is needed is the six digit serial number that was assigned to the car; however, the complete data plate information and codes are helpful to make the information on a certain Thunderbird complete.

STARTING PROBLEMS

If you are having starting problems because your engine doesn't always crank over properly when you hit the starter, the problem may be due to a poor ground connection between the engine block and the firewall or battery ground cable. It's nice to have lots of shiny paint on the engine block and firewall but remember paint

won't conduct electricity and the bolt itself isn't enough surface contact to do the job. Be sure to scrape away the paint on the engine block where the engine ground strap attaches and also for 55 and 56's where the battery ground cable is bolted. Do the same at the firewall and you will be assured of a good electrical connection.

RADIATOR HOSE CLAMPS

CASCO now has reproduced the original radiator hose clamps!


When our local supplier closed up shop, we lost our source for radiator hose clamps. So we located some original clamps and were surprised that there were quite a few differences between what we have sold for 30 some years and the original clamps.

We made the decision to make these parts in house and got to work making the tooling and developing the manufacturing process. Now we have most correct radiator hose clamps that we have ever been able to offer to the hobby. Right down to the correct fillister head screw, these are concours show quality clamps!


Order the upper hose clamp by part number 8287A, \$4.20 each.

The lower hose clamp is 8287B for \$4.25 each.

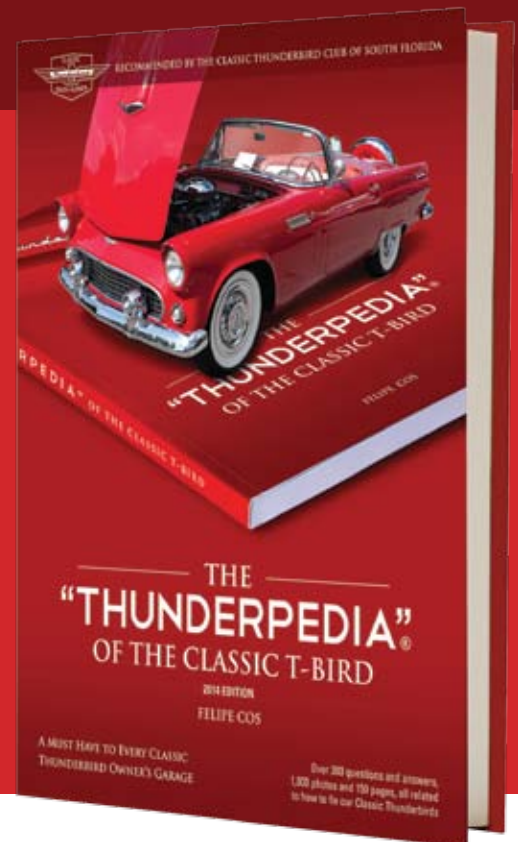
