






The ADF

Consequently their portrayal of two old codgers fulfilling repressed adventures, inspired all of us to start listing things we want to do or accomplish before our final run. Well what if there is something you need to do but aren't aware of the requisite desire? Frank and I had this deja vu experience when we were invited to attend a big event; Specialty Equipment Manufacturers Association (SEMA) in Las Vegas, NV. Here we realized this show was something we should have wanted all along and so felt like, on a smaller scale, that we had been there before. We had to find a way to label this phenomenon. which we shall term, Accidental Desire Fulfillment. or ADF.

As we explored the huge venue we could not get enough of the displays, the cars, the equipment and of course the celebrities. Frank had a couple of car favorites, the best being the Plymouth Super Bird.














Now besides all the equipment and displays there are many venues where one can get an adrenalin rush. Such was the case of the Ford Ride Along experience. Ford had laid out a mini autocross course combined with an off road venue. I had waited in line a long time and by luck was the last one to get a ride in a Ford Cobra! This car could really fly. Being the last one of the day the driver tried to scare me, impossible, and also wear the tread off the tires, probable. I had a great thrilling asphalt adventure in the high powered sports car. After, as I got ready to leave I showed the attendants pictures of my 1957 Thunderbird and they allowed me to ride along with Frank on the off road course in the Raptor trucks. You can't buy luck, but on this day in the city of odds and heart ache, lady luck smiled upon me. The truck ride was unbelievable. Flying over 'whop de doos' at full speed, you could barely feel the huge bumps on the course. Flying more than 30 feet in the air over the jump the touchdown was almost as smooth as one of Franks Landings in a Boeing 777.




