RALLYE INFORMATION

WHAT TYPE OF RALLY:

This will be a European Style Rally, such as the Italian Mille Miglia (1,000 Miles) Rally. This will be a rally for fun with the purpose to teach you how to run a European style rally and prepare you to participate in other types of rallies. Any person that can continuously keep the same speed for 2 or 3 miles can make this rally. Once you've done one of these rallies, you can easily adapt to and follow any other type of rally.

WHAT DO YOU NEED:

A navigator (passenger), a GPS, a stop watch, and of course, a car. There will be two classes for the competition, cars up to 1999 and from 2000 to current.

WHY THE NAVIGATOR? On the morning of the Rally, you will be issued the Rally Road Book. The book will contain turn by turn instructions which will guide you to each destination and it will also tell you what speed you must maintain between certain road markers, and you must record the time that it took you from one marker to the other. Obviously, you cannot read the book, interpret the instructions, work the stop watch, and record the times, while at the same time, driving the automobile, that's where the Navigator comes in. The navigator will be in charge of telling you where to turn and at what speed you must be going, he/she will also be working the stop watch and recording the times where indicated by the Rally Book. The GPS, although NOT allowed in most rallies, will be OK for this rally. Since you will not know the actual destination point of each leg, the GPS as a navigator, will not be practical, it only use will be to act as a speedometer for your vehicle. Older, and even some newer cars, are not 100% correct when indicating the speed.

Following the GPS speed you will give you a better chance of getting it right.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

All of the instructions will be relayed to you by the Navigator as he/she follows the Rally Road Book. You will be leaving from the starting point and will follow the instructions at any speed you desire until you reach the beginning of an AUTO CONTROL, indicated by an odd number, where you will START YOUR STOP WATCH and drive at the designated speed until you pass the end of the AUTO CONTROL, indicated by an even number, where you will STOP THE STOPWATCH and write your time control in the book.

You may continue at any desired speed until the next AUTO CONTROL.

Example: Numbers 1, 3, 5, etc. are all beginnings for each AUTO CONTROL, while numbers 2, 4, 6, etc., are the ending for each one. IE: 1-2, 3-4, 5-6 will be the first three AUTO CONTROLS and you will record the ending times at 2, 4, and 6.

Once you have completed all of the segments (AUTO CONTROLS) you will copy the time for each one to the appropriate space on the last page of the book. That last page will be turned in at the end of the day where we will validate your times.

Only the organizers know the exact time that it will take for you to complete each AUTO CONTROL. Provided that you maintained the constant speed as indicated, your times for each segment should match your recorded time.

Any seconds over or under will be your penalty points. We will only deduct a maximum penalty of 60 seconds for each leg.

You will each start with 1,000 points and the winner will be the one with the most points at the end.

PRACTICE:

There will be one AUTO CONTROL at the beginning, labeled A and B, A will be the start and B will be the end. You will time this control, just as you

would the regularly numbered control, ONLY, for this control, we will give you the correct answer. You should check this against your actual time and determine if you did anything wrong, should do it again to feel more at ease, or if you are right on the mark! If you do the same leg multiple times, you will most likely get as many different times, just remember, within 60 seconds either way, you are in the game. The differences may be caused because you clicked on the stop watch a little too early or a little too late, or you relaxed your foot off the accelerator, or someone got in the way and you had to compensate to the time deviance, any number of reasons!

INSTRUCTION (Rally Road) BOOK:

In the instructions book you will have 7 columns:

Column #1- The instruction number.

Column #2- The approximate distance from the starting point to the designated end point of each leg.

There will not be any mileage shown on the AUTO CONTROLS.

Column #3- The approximate distance from the previous instruction to the next instruction.

This section is very important; if you have traveled this distance or more, and you have not seen the next road marker as indicated in the book, then you took a wrong turn.

If this happens GO BACK to the completion of the last instructions and try again.

Column #4- The actions you have to make [turn left, turn right, go straight, etc. etc.]

Column #5- The road sign where you initiate the previous column instruction #4; it could be a signal light, a mile marker, a speed signal, etc. etc.

Column #6- Advises the beginning and the end of the auto control Uneven number is the beginning of AUTO CONTROL. Even number is the end of AUTO CONTROL. Also it will show the speed you have to drive at this AUTO CONTROL.

Column #7- Write your time.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:

Rally will start EXACTLY at 7.00 a.m. PM Friday, September 16 and will finish at the hotel.

Trophies will be presented on Saturday September 17, right after the Poolside BBQ.

You have to follow the designated speed only within the

AUTO CONTROL, other than that; you may go at any speed you desire.

ALWAYS follow the speed limits AND obey all traffic laws.

In the rally you will never drive over 55 mph.

This rally "for fun" is a non-profit event; the money charged is only to cover the expenses of the rally like course preparation, books, trophies, etc..

Net proceeds will be donated to a charity. For the 2016 Rally, it will be the Cystic Fibrosis Research foundation.

This is a FAMILY event, you may bring your children, other family members, or friends in the car with you.

Be very carefully with the speed limit when you are not within

an AUTO CONTROL, you will be passing several small towns with low posted limits.



Our 1956 Thunderbird

It was early November in 1998 my wife, Robin, was complaining that I had just purchased a new Corvette and she wanted a new car as well! We agreed to go to the Auto Show on Miami Beach to check out what was new and exciting. The only new and exciting model I saw was a Mitsubishi hard top convertible with a power operated top which was displayed on a rotating platform. There was alleged to be only one of these available in South Florida at South Motors. It was strange why they were displaying a vehicle that was not readily available for sale. The only other models that interested me were in the Million Dollar Alley Display (too expensive) and the Memory Lane display by the Miami Chapter of the AACA and those cars were not listed for sale.

I left the auto show with two thoughts:

- 1.Check out the Mitsubishi hard top convertible at South Motors. I did go to see it at South Moors with my wife. The vehicle was inside their tiny showroom with a dead battery and not available for a test drive. The salesman recommended that I test drive a similar car with the same engine which I did not do. The car was overpriced (only one available), and underpowered and was reported to have a problem with the power top failing if exposed to freezing weather (a big problem in South Florida) I was advised that this vehicle was also being discontinued.
- 2. The cars in Memory Lane also intrigued me and I told my wife I decided what her next car would be, but I wanted it to be a total surprise for her.

For some unknown reason my Wife had a toy model 1956 Peacock Blue Thunderbird on her desk at our office



for many years, so I decided she must have liked that car. Therefore, I started exploring finding her the real thing in Peacock Blue. It would have to have an automatic transmission as well as Air Conditioning. I contacted Amos Minter in Dallas Texas who had what I was looking for.

He had a body off, frame off Peacock Blue restoration with only 14 test miles on it, so I purchased the car over the phone without ever seeing it or driving it, with the agreement I could return it and only be responsible for the freight charges if I decided I did not want it.

The surprise for my wife was almost ruined when the transport driver called my house looking how to find my home. I came up with a wild story to my wife that is was a mechanic looking for a job that was trying to find my house. The car was dropped off early the next morning while my wife was still asleep and the surprise was not ruined.

Was she surprised when I woke her up to see the special car sitting in our driveway for her. Her first reaction was she was going to love driving it to work. I explained that the car was for pleasure use only and was never going to work with her.

She would have to settle with driving her Lincoln Navigator to work.

Soon after that, we met Felipe & Daisy & Felix at a car show in South Dade and I immediately joined the T-Bird club. It turned out I already knew Felix for many years who was a customer of mine since 1970.

The T-Bird currently has only 14,000 miles logged on it from its frame off rebuild.

It is not a trailer queen and is driven on special occasions, to T-Bird functions, and to car shows.

- It is kept in perfect mechanical condition and is stored in an air conditioned garage along with several other classic cars that we own.
- I have tried to keep the car as original looking as possible, however necessary improvements that I have made are as follows:
- 1. Heavy duty sway bar in the front.
- 2. Bolt on sway bar added in the rear.
- 3. Monroe adjustable height air shocks in the rear.
- 4. Full chrome plated wire spoke wheels.
- 5. Radial tires.





- 6. An original soft top & frame. (Car was purchased with a hard top only)
- 7. Painting of the AC unit peacock blue to match the interior.
- 8. Volt, amp, oil pressure, and temp gage bolted onto the AC unit also painted peacock blue.
- 9. A complete personal re-build by me of the Town & Country radio to get it working.
- 10. Replacement of the interior carpeting.
- 11. Keeping with the 50's style, mice, dice, and 'Winky the Cat' also decorate the interior.

TECH TALK

What type of motor oil should I use in my classic T-Bird?

The Ford Motor Company recommends SAE 20, or SAE 30 Grade motor oil for temperatures always above freezing. I have read many articles that contradict what the Ford Motor Company recommends, including an article in the Nov-Dec 2015 Early Bird publication, and again in the July-August 2016 Early Bird publication.

In any engine, the most important thing to do is to use the correct viscosity motor oil as recommended by the Manufacturer to provide adequate lubrication and limit engine wear. This is more important than the zinc & phosphorus recommended for engines with flat tappet cams. If the oil is either too thin or too thick, adequate lubrication does not occur.

20 weight motor oil has a centistoke kinematic viscosity between 5.6 & 9.6

30 weight motor oil has a centistoke kinematic viscosity between 9.3 & 12.5

40 weight motor oil has a centistoke kinematic viscosity between 12.5 & 16.3

50 weight motor oil has a centistoke kinematic viscosity between 16.3 & 21.9

At a kinematic viscosity below 5.6 or above 12.5, adequate lubrication cannot be maintained in our classic T-Birds, and therefore 40 weight or 50 weight motor oil should never be used in them.

All SAE motor oils thicken and their viscosity increases accordingly per the centistoke kinematic viscosity ratings above as the temperature of the oil increases. (Multi viscosity oils such as 10W-30 start out as 10 weight motor oil and

increase to 30 weight motor oil as the temperature of the oil increases.) In addition, the motor oil does not provide optimum lubrication until the engine reaches its normal operating temperature. Most motor oils provide hardly any protection when the engine is first started, and therefore getting the engine up to normal operating temperature as quickly as possible is highly desirable.

No Motor Oil Manufacturer that I am aware of recommends adding anything to their complex formulation as you purchase it. As zinc & phosphorus are also needed in our T-Birds your choices to find the best motor oil to use directly from the Oil Manufacturers are limited.

Three (3) brands that I am aware of that already have the correct amount of ZDDP are:

- **a.** Brad Penn-partial synthetic, certified by the American Petroleum Institute (API)
- **b.** Royal Purple HPS 10W-30 full synthetic. (This formulation is not certified by the AP1)
- **c.** Amsoil SAE-10W-30 Z-Rod full synthetic, certified by the API..

Whereas there is currently many 20W-50 diesel motor oil brands available with high levels of zinc & phosphorus, when this oil heats up you are way out of range to provide adequate lubrication within a standard T-Bird engine that was never designed to use above a 30 weight oil.




