Ed wanted to mention that Norm took pictures on his drone at Sebring.


Our car show which was mentioned after we adjourned will be on Sunday, January 29th, 2017 at Tropical Park, which is a week before super bowl Sunday.
















The Felipe Cos Memorial Florida 300 Mile Rally/ Tour

Also there were a few rare cars in there including an unrestored, original Type 1 convertible, he found in Argentina!


Another convertible sported a post-war radio that had only German city names on the dial, because immediately after World War 2, German cities only had one station each!

So WE knew were We were going, and sure enough, as we pulled off the side of the road, everyone followed us. Since we were the lead car.



TECH TALK CORNER

T-BIRD TECH REMINDER

Why modern motor oils may not be good for Our Thunderbird Engines



Zinc Dithiophosphate (ZDDP) is no longer available in most modern motor oils. Our Thunderbird engines require the ZDDP to provide lubricity to prevent premature camshaft wear (i.e. costly engine rebuild).

Some motor oils have ZDDP in them, such as Joe Gibbs Break-in Oil, Valvoline VR1 Racing Oil, or Eastwood ZDDP oil additive for classic vehicles that were manufactured before 1989.

The Eastwood product can be added at the time of an oil change if you use a modern engine oil or synthetic oil.

Remember our old T-bird engines were designed to use ZDDP in the oil because we have flat tappet cam and valve train.






