



Classic Thunderbird Club SFL Show



Our Club's 17th Annual Open Car Show was held on the most beautiful Spring day yet in Florida. Unlike the orignal day planned in January, which had to be the worst day of rain and coldest tempuratures of the year, the weather was fantastic! Sunny clear in the high 70's with a delightful breeze. The "hard core" members arrived by 7am to help Oscar put up the tents and tables. On the way I saw Paul and Anita pulled over on the Palmetto Expressway with a flat tire. We checked Paul's spare which looked good, but there was no jack. I flagged a Road Ranger who was only able to nod back since he was in traffic two lanes over. Anita got the AAA on the phone and arranged a rescue. The Road Rangers arrived shortly with the AAA truck almost simutanously, the tire was changed and they were on their way.

Almost 200 stunning Classics Hot Rods Muscle and Sports cars and trucks attended, from a 1929 Ford Model T to a 2017, 700+ HP Dodge Challanger Hellcat!


