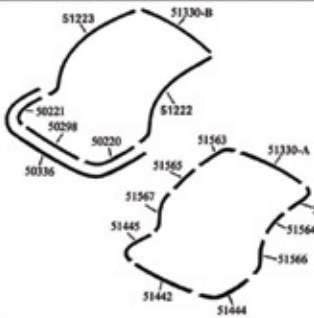

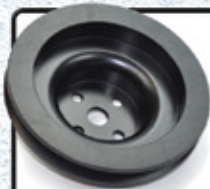

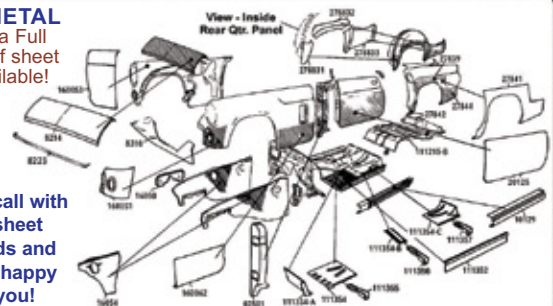

When Bridget introduced herself to Colonel Zimmerman he insisted we call him AL. Bridget learned that Al was not only a pilot but also an Army Ranger. Bridget's brother Bob was an Army Ranger, so she inquired, "Have you ever met a Bob Stack?" Al exclaimed, "do you mean Colonel Bob Stack?" Al and Bob had spent many days together at different Army Posts and knew each other well. Small world!

It is our honor to help commemorate this special observance and help others recognize the significance of Memorial Day. If we forget our history then we are doomed to repeat it; we should always remember that we breathe free because others have sacrificed and given their all to protect us.
