



Hello Fellow Members!

Registrations are now open for the Road Trip to the Sebring Thunder in September and the 2017 8th edition of the 300 Mile Rally in October! Keep an eye out for emails and check our website, www.tbirdfl.com, for the latest updates to the itinerary for each event.

IMPORTANT, Hotel reservations are filling up, please register and then reserve your hotel room, they are going FAST! On July 19th, when the registrations opened, we already had 23 rooms booked by people who reserved before we even opened the registration! For the 300 Mile Rally, all King rooms are gone, you can go on standby, but I doubt any of us will cancel. Only Queen and Double rooms remain.

The registration for the Miami to Sebring Thunder Car Show will go up on August 1st, then again on August 16, and will CLOSE on August 31. We have to follow the pricing schedule instituted by the Sebring Thunder organization. NO GATE REGISTRATIONS will be accepted for this event.

It is very important that those of you that already have rooms reserved, that you PLEASE go online and register for the event at www.tbirdfl.com. We need to match our list with the one from the hotel, since the room discount will only apply to the registered participants.

Between Elvis and I, we have taken three road trips up and down the central part of Florida to plan both the September Road Trip and the 2017 8th Edition of the 300 Mile Rally! (Thank You Elvis!) There are still a few more trips pending to finalize the route and then more trips to check, re-check, and triple check the measurements, sorry Elvis, but when we do those last 3 trips, which is when the auto-controls are timed and defined, I will go with Marcia and you will have to stay home. Dezer Museum Ft Lauderdale





Classic Thunderbird Club SF members joined with The Mercury Club on Saturday July 8th for an outing at the New Dezer Car Museum located inside the Xtreme action Park in Ft Lauderdale.

Mike McNeal as President of the Mercury Club who is also a Thunderbird Club member got a group of both club's members together to visit this recently opened collection. Among our CTCSF members attending were Daisy and Felix, Olga and Johnny, Anita and Paul with Arlene and myself.

This 2nd Dezer collection is similar to the Miami location, but even at a whopping 30,000 square feet is small in comparison. The Miami location is housed in 2 buildings with over 50,000 square feet! You need to go through the Xtreme Action Park entrance to buy your entry tickets. There is also Xtreme go kart racing if you are in the mood!

The Dezer Showroom is divided up among several themes. The Roaring 20's, Rolls Royce, Hollywood Movie Stars and Cars, Military, 50s Land Yachts and Micro Cars.

The Hollywood car collection was fantastic! A Back to the Future DeLorean, a Batmobile, Captain Nemo's Cruiser from The League of Extraordinary Gentlemen, and Marilyn Monroe and Elvis Tribute Cars.

All kinds of Military vehicles including a "Duck"! This one was all original in full military gear, not a tour bus like the kind that ferries tourists up and down Duval Street in Key West!













As Paul and I wondered around the "Havana Nights" Exhibit of late 50's cruisers we both found cars we had in common. A 1959 Edsel, Paul had a 58 and I have a 59

A 59 Chrysler Imperial like the one his Grandfather owned and a 59 Cadillac just like MY Grandfather owned, right down to the model and color!





The Mini cars were stacked on racks to the ceiling!

We spent the most amount of time there. Tandem seat Messerschmitt cars, Fiats, makes we never heard of and shapes we have never seen!

One car, a Zundapp Janus looked the same from the front or back! Was it coming or going? It was built by the Zundapp motorcycle company in post WWII Germany to answer the need for inexpensive and affordable car that could up to hold 4 people.

To save production cost it was designed with occupant entry through matching doors, one the front and one in the back. The front vent windows matched the rear and the left and right-side windows were identical, too! The car was appropriately named, Janus from the Roman God who appeared to have two faces, one on each side of his head. Only 6,900



cars were produced in 1957-58 due to poor sales and the production facility sold to Bosch. This a rare one indeed!



Most of the cars in the collection are presented in original condition right down to the tires

We were told that a themed restaurant facility was being created that could be reserved for parties located just behind the Presidential Limo and cardboard
