



## MINUTES OF MEETING

#### **BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Paul Werner, Oscar Castro, Ed Raabe, Stuart Corenblum, Gail Corenblum, Daniel Romagnoli, Leo Saladino, Peter Klein

CALL TO ORDER President Paul Werner called the meeting to order at 7:20. He began by discussing how to organize the board meetings. It was decided that the structure for the executive board will be loose, and if meetings are necessary, we will try to meet by conference call.

**OLD BUSINESS:** REDLANDS RIOT ROAD RALLYE: Oscar encouraged us to pre-register our vehicles as there is usually a delay at the registration table onsite. Dinner will be at Oscar and Marcia's home and is a free, Member Benefit event to all paid up club members.

#### **CAR SHOW JANUARY 28:**

Oscar said that everything is going smoothly. He has registered the event with the park with attendance capped at 350 so as not to incur the need for a second police officer. #### 40 Million Fire Extinguishers Recalled

#### Please check yours ASAP!

Just recently a recall was announced involving 40 million fire extinguishers manufactured by Kidde. The recall involves 134 models of Kidde fire extinguishers manufactured between January 1, 1973 and August 15, 2017, including models that were previously recalled in March 2009 and February 2015. Be advised that some of the recalled extinguishers were sold under names other than Kidde (i.e. Fuller Brush, Honeywell, Montgomery Ward, Sears and other names).

#### Kidde Fire Extinguisher Product Safety Recall Information or kidde.com

Be advised that the link above has the list of recalled extinguishers. It also lets you submit your request for a replacement extinguisher after you provide your name, address, the model extinguisher and serial number. It verifies that your extinguisher is being recalled and submits your request for a replacement.

If you do not want to submit your request online, you can contact Kidde via telephone to find out if a fire extinguisher is included in the recall or to get a replacement.

Contact Kidde at 855-271-0773 between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. EST Monday-Friday (excluding holidays), or between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. during the weekend to determine whether your extinguishers are affected.

Given how many AACA members have fire extinguishers for their vehicles, we have no doubt that some AACA members have extinguishers that are being recalled. Please take action on this situation immediately and be sure to share this information with all of your region and chapter members as soon as possible.


