## **18th Annual Club Car Show**

The weather prediction turned dire by the middle of the week before our Sunday show with 80% change of thunderstorms predicted by noon! We all figured we were going to get a repeat of last year's washout, but Oscar informed us, Rain or Shine , the show MUST go on, no rain date! Well, someone "upstairs' must have heard our prayers, because late Saturday afternoon, the forcast completely changed to clouds with mixed sun and only a slight chance of a storm around 6pm!

Perfect Car Show weather, Sunny breezy and in the 70's made for an incredible day!

This show featured the biggest varity of cars we ever had! From Paul Cotner's Model A to a limited production car based on the Pontiac F Body called the Trojan there were some unique Marques. The Pontiac Trojan was built by Knudsen Automotive from 1985-1991. These cars were commisioned by GM to be built as an affordable alternative to the Ferrari!

Many of the styling ques invoke the Ferrari 305. 150 are thought to have been produced during that time. The buyer would go to a Pontiac Dealer and order the car, customized to your specs, priced from \$21,500 up to \$55K depending on how wild you got with the engine mods and creature comforts. The white example at our Show features the Lambroghini Countach wing!

I was especially happy to see the terrific voluteer turnout by the Club membership. Everything goes much smoother when we have a lot of help. Thank you all for continuing to make the Annual Club Car show a Successful Event!

Of the many incredible Cars most notworthy to us Thunderbird Aficionados, is the Principality of Monaco Edition 1963 Thundebird owned by Steve and Myrna Wishnick, driven all the way from Punta Gorda! (That earned them the Longest Distance award). I first met Steve and Myna a few years ago when they traveled down for the Ed Morse Show in Sunrise. They are a great couple who love to enlighten you about their unique "Princess".

In 1963 Ford built only 2,000 of these special editon cars that became commonly known as the Princess of Monaco. A dark rose-colored long grain vinyl top with landau irons on each side "graces" the Corinthian white body. Inside, a white steering wheel, leather interior,

rosewood dash and accents are exclusive to this edition. Power, the 300hp 390cu in Z Code was standard and an M Code 340hp tri-power could be orderd. Steve and Myrna drive their car everyware without hesitation. He told me it cruises all day long at 65 mph with plenty of passing power whenever needed. Remember, the drive from Puta Gorda is over 260 miles round trip. Plenty of opportunity to "open it up" on the Highway.

This Summer the car will appear at the AACA Musum in Hershey PA included in a special presentation and at the ITC International Convention in Buffalo, NY August 7-12th

Another Unique Car, a 1959 Ford Galaxie Skyliner was displayed by Thunderbird Club member, Bob Mayer. Bob has many Classic cars including the stunning Red 57 Thunderbird that he showed last year, but he says this Skyliner is his favorite! Back in the mid 1950s Ford designers woked on a retractable hard top design intended for the Lincoln Mk 2 Continental.

That concept was applied to the 1957 and 58 Fairlane and finally in 1959 to the new top of the line Galaxie.





## MINUTES OF MEETING

### CALL TO ORDER

In President Paul Werner's absence, the meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Leo Saladino, vice president. Leo apologized for Paul's necessary absence.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Peter Klein reported that the treasury is in good shape and we have the money we'll need to continue to enjoy our social events. But Peter reminded us of the necessity of getting as many drivers as possible for the April auction. He plans to send out emails every two weeks for reminders and requests. Peter told us that the driving would be at our comfort level. If we were asked to drive a vehicle in which we wouldn't be comfortable, a different car would be appointed. The driving is up the ramp to the building entrance, after which the car would be pushed by auction personnel onto the stage. Then it's a drive to the circular turnstile and out. This year we have not been asked to drive for unloading and there is not an auction on Sunday. Our drivers are needed Friday, Saturday and Monday. The Mercury Club could supply 8-10 drivers and the Studebaker Club could help also, but we need as many for our club as we can muster. Members are asked to bring friends. Oscar told us that our dues are only \$35 per year, but the club spends approximately \$280 for each member couple. We depend on the funds from the auction.

### OLD BUSINESS:

### CAR SHOW JANUARY 28, REPORT:

Oscar told us that he is working on finding a sponsor for the tee shirts for next year. He explained that he had asked 6 unbiased attendees to judge for the Best of Show. The class judging is by attendees. The profit from the show was \$906 and the net to the club was \$530 after the \$376 donation to McPherson College.

The Club will pay for breakfast for all paid members in attendance. Paul will send out further information. A show of hands was requested and 8 people said they are planning to go.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Raul is opposed to the club spending money on tee shirts for the car show and reducing the club profit when everyone works so hard on the event. He made a motion that we should only give



out tee shirts if they are paid for by a sponsor, at no expense to the club. Poppy seconded. Ed explained that the board decided on spending money on tee shirts as an enticement for better registration of cars at the show. Leo also talked about the need for goodie bags for participants. It's come to be expected at shows. Oscar asked that ALL members try to get business people to donate for the goodie bags.

Bob Heslekrants asked if he could make a friendly amendment to Raul's motion that tee shirts would be offered for sale at registration. Raul agreed. The motion was amended and passed unanimously (The Club will not fund tee shirts for the car show. They will either be sponsored or purchased by participants).

### INTERNATIONAL THUNDERBIRD CLUB:

Ed reminded us that Felipe Cos had founded our club 20 years ago this November as a chapter of Classic Thunderbird International Club, chapter 114. CTCI is one of three national Thunderbird clubs (CTCI, Vintage Thunderbird Club and International Thunderbird Club), but they are the only one exclusively devoted to the early birds, 1955-57. Ed and Paul were approached by International Thunderbird Club for membership. ITC gives support to all Birds, 1955 through 2005: Retro Birds, newer birds, early birds, little birds, square birds, flare birds, bullet birds, glamour birds. They offer a welcome package, a magazine, Script, that is published bimonthly, a very active Facebook page, and most importantly, they can offer support to all Bird owners and our club membership includes Thunderbirds of various years. They will be having an international convention (this year, August 7-12 in Buffalo, NY). Ed has spoken with the Buffalo chapter president Todd Ruth who and nothing but great things to say about his Clubs' participation with ITC. We can still continue in the CTCI. Jane is doing well, still singing and dancing. Bob takes her home on weekends and is looking into keeping her at home.
