



Incoming President Richard Manso thanked everyone for their confidence and acceptance. Richard said that only having been a member for 4 years makes this an honor and that he promises to do his best.

UPCOMING EVENTS:

AUCTION REPORT: Because of remodeling at the Broward Convention Center, the auction will be held this year at the Palm Beach International Raceway (formally MOROSO Speedway). The auction dates are March 20 and 21, but as in previous years, we will be suppling drivers for unloading vehicles on March 17-19 and reloading on March 23. As the logistics of the site will make travel difficult for our drivers, the Board has decided to rent a house 30 minutes from the auction site so that drivers working 2 or more days can stay over and not have the additional drive home and back. We will first do our best to use our own drivers, but if need be, we will be contacting the clubs in Palm Beach, Jupiter, etc. for help with driving. Bob Obenland volunteered to put up drivers at his home in Boynton Beach, about 45 minutes from the venue, and both he and the Runcks will see if they can find drivers in their locales. We have requested that RM/Sotheby's help us with money for lodging, but we have not yet heard back. RM has requested 6 drivers for unloading on Tuesday, March 17, 12 each day for Wednesday and Thursday, and on Friday and Saturday they will want us to supply about 20-25 drivers. We pay other clubs for their participation, so we'd much prefer to be able to handle the event with our own club members. This event, along with our car show, is how the club is able to give members all of the extras that we do. Mike McNeal will be the contact person for drivers.



































2019 THUNDERBIRD CLUB'S FELIPE COS MEMORIAL 300 MILE RALLY

Friday we que up for the 7am launch, but first those who need it, gas up at a station right there!






Off we go! 7:08am. For added


