For the past 63 years I have owned my 1957 Thunderbird. It was my daily-driver until the mid 1970's when I parked it in my garage until I retired in 2001.

When I retired, my wife said, "What are you going to do with that old car?!!!"

After I evaluated the cost of restoring it, I thought, "Oh boy, that much! It will cost me more to restore it than it is worth!! That is, unless I do most of the restoration myself. Can I really do that??"

Well, with the help of a lot of good friends and reading a lot of 'how-to-do-it' books, it took **only** 3.5 years for the job.

The photos show many of the activities that I did to make the old T-bird almost new again.

I estimate that I spent 6 hours per day, 4 days a week on the project. If you calculate that out, it's 44,928 hours. I know the professionals charge a lot for their labor but if I paid myself \$20.00 per hour that comes to \$89,760.00 for my time spent.

The total cost for parts, body shop and transmission was \$18,025.71 plus \$6245.00 for the engine rebuild by Ed Campbell.

GRAND TOTAL = \$114,030.71

Was it worth it ---- DEFINITLY. A lot of work but also a lot of fun, and I learned a great deal in the process as well as made a lot of wonderful new friends.
