



Lakeland Florida was the site of the 2022 Lake Mirror Classic Concours & Car Show sponsored by Mid Florida Credit Union the weekend of October 14-16th. Directed by Robert D' Angelo this is an annual Event comprised of 3 Shows and

a Rallye, which host over 35,000 attendees!

Friday night the Hot Rod Rendezvous of 100+ cars, Saturday, the Concours D' Elegance with 150 of the Crème- de-la -crème automobiles in the region and a Street Show of over 350 cars of all kinds. Sunday is a Vintage Road Rallye. All in all, a massive undertaking!

Arlene and I have wanted to show our Thunderbird at this event (we have been coming since 1999 long before we got the T Bird). We even came the year the show field was washed out and the event was held in the city parking garages! COVID 2020 took its toll and there was a



year when it wasn't held. It seemed it would never happen again when Mid Florida announced they were ending sponsorship. Robert D'Angelo came to the rescue with his expertise of running large Classic Car events (the Annual Memorial Day Weekend Bay Life Church show in nearby Brandon exhibits close to 800 cars) His relationship with Mid Florida Credit Union got the ball rolling again for the Lake Mirror Classic and this year it was just like "Old Times.

We were out on Friday night at the Hot Rod Rendezvous with Club members John & Celia Layzell and Alan & Hellen Runck following the Club Dinner at Harry's and ran into Mel Mann, our friend from the AACA South Florida Region, this year's Concours Chief Judge, a well-deserved honor. It was late and he was still running around greeting people and making final plans. This Mann has unlimited energy! His team of judges had a big challenge with 150 Cars in 21 classes! They exceeded all expectations.

Now about the Thunderbirds. Our 1955 Thunderbird was exhibited the Street Show, since being modified with nonoriginal air conditioning, it did not qualify for the Concours. That allowed us to be together with other Thunderbirds from Clubs in the region. As luck would have it, Arlene and I were staying at the same Hotel as members of the Trailbirds of Southwest Florida, Dave and Betty Tulowitzky's Club. I ran into Dave by the elevator Friday evening and made arrangements to go in with his group in the morning. I also arranged with David Claycomb of the Florida Gulf Coast Vintage Thunderbirds (Charles Inman, President) to have them meet up at the Hotel so we could be together, our goal a street full of T-Birds!
