



### Bob's Tragic Story with a Wonderful Ending!

The Yearlong Saga of My Little Bird – Bob Obenland

Last January (2022) my daughter and I were on our way to the last Club Show at the racetrack in Homestead. We were on the toll road, five or six miles away, when a speeding car approached us from behind, on our right, crossing our lane and hitting us on the rear left panel. They sped off before we could get a license plate number. After reporting the accident to the FHP we proceeded to the show. Now the fun begins!



I contacted my insurance (Hagerty) and they gave me six body shops in the area. Four of them did not work



on cars as old as my Bird. The other two were able to do restorations. After talking and checking those out I decided to go with one in West Palm Beach. They looked at the damage and came to the same conclusion I did in that it could not be repaired without a new left rear quarter panel. They indicated that when I could find the panel it would then be three months before they could start.

I started last February (2022) looking for the quarter panel by calling all Thunderbird part suppliers I could find and ones they suggested I try. The only thing I could fine was National Parts Depot who sold one four years ago for \$5,000. We then located one on eBay which I purchased, only to find out that we were scammed. Who scams people on auto parts? My daughter then joined some T-Bird Facebook groups and told them of our problem. We found that two people, whose grandfathers were going to restore a Bird but never started, had new Ford quarter panels that were in storage for decades. One was in Texas but a little expensive



and less reliable, the other was in Ohio with both the left and right panel selling for \$4,000. Only one problem, I had to buy both. So now I'm in the parts business. At this point I decided to buy both on May 11th. I received the panels at the end of the month and, by June 1<sup>st</sup>; I had the panel in the body shop. At this point I assumed the three month wait would begin. I called the shop every month to check on the status of getting my car in, only to find that my bird was getting pushed to the end of the year. At the end of 2022 I spoke with the shop and he said he was making some changes to the shop that was why he was not getting back to me. In all accounts, I am still under the impression that the shop would eventually get to my car, though, in January, I received a call from the shop informing me that he was going out of business. The only good that came out of this was that he gave me the name of a shop in Ft Lauderdale that Hagerty did not know about.



I then had to get my panel from the shop, coming to the conclusion that it was going to live in my car until I could find a new shop. I contacted the shop in Ft Lauderdale (Fabulous Restorations) on January 30<sup>th</sup> and found it to be a large shop that only worked on vintage

cars. They looked at the picture of my car and wanted me to bring the car in for them to see the damage. I brought the car in on January 31 (the one-year anniversary of the accident) and they said they could fix the car. I asked them


when they could start only to find out that they were able to begin the next day. I brought the car in the next day and found that I could also hang out and watch them disassemble the car. I took advantage of this and spent February  $2^{nd}$  watching them take apart the car while also ordering parts per the request of the shop. I was also able to purchase a new back bumper along with having the front bumper re-



chromed. As parts came in, I would deliver them and as of the end of February 2023, my little Bird was fixed!
