1937 Packard 115C Rumble Seat Convertible



1937 115C purchased in Florida in 2013. The car was sold new in Orlando in 1937. Car was disassembled and stripped. All rusted metal has been removed and replaced – including floor, trunk, rocker and quarter panels, door and panel bottoms and wheel wells wherever necessary. New smooth running boards have been fabricated. Original repairable running boards are included. New steel subfloor has been fabricated and all wood has been removed and replaced with steel, including the trunk and rumble seat door and interior. The original top frame has not yet been worked on, and it does need some wood replacement. The original motor and transmission are not available. The original rear end is installed and a Ford 9" is available. We have secured and purchased missing items, including bumper brackets, headlight and taillight buckets, and chrome side hood pieces. The center hood chrome strip is missing. The windshield frame has been re-chromed. All door and window hardware is included. Original bumpers are included and need work.

Time and energy have not permitted us to complete this project. We had hoped to have it looking like this:
